Engaging the Lost, There Are No Exceptions for Life Sharing

John 3:1-18

The best model for life sharing is the life of Jesus Himself. Jesus came into the world to engage the lost, lived for the sake of their lives, and for this very purpose, He carried the cross and saved mankind. There are no exceptions for engaging the lost. This is because everyone is a sinner before God and a very one in need of salvation. Nicodemus, known as a Bible scholar, was also a lost soul who needed Jesus.

1. Looking back on the past week, share the most memorable life sharing experience.
2. Nicodemus, who came to Jesus late at night, heard the word of being born again and experienced a spiritual change. At first, Nicodemus did not understand Jesus' words that he had to be born again. What does it mean for a person to be born again? When did you personally meet Jesus and experience the rebirth of your soul?
3. How does Jesus describe a person being born again? (Verses 5-8) What is the difference between being baptized with water and being baptized with the Holy Spirit? How do we react when we think that the baptism of the Holy Spirit is given only by God's grace?
4. Nicodemus, a Pharisee who was knowledgeable in the Bible and the most respected leader in Jewish society, also needed Jesus. If he had not been born again, he would have been born in the flesh and lived as a mere religious person before his life came to an end. If there are people around us who are outstanding in their religious activities or live good ethical lives but do not know the Lord, please share them and pray for their souls to be saved.

Jesus answered him, "Truly, truly, I say to you, unless one is born again he can not see the kingdom of God." (John 3:3)
